
IAQ MEMBERSHIP DISTRIBUTION





ASQ'S LANCASTER AWARD/MEDAL

DEAR ACADEMICIANS

The E. Jack Lancaster Medal Committee is accepting nominations for the Medal for the 2001-2002 award year. The successful nominee/recipient will receive the Medal at the Awards Luncheon held in conjunction with the 56th Annual Quality Congress of the American Society for Quality in Denver, Colorado, USA, May 20-22, 2002.

The E. Jack Lancaster Medal is presented to the individual who has been recognized by the committee for dedication, leadership, and outstanding contributions to the international fraternity of qual-

ity professionals. The Lancaster Medal Committee may propose not more than one nominee to the Society's Award Board each year. The nominee, who has not previously received the Lancaster Medal/Award, must have demonstrated exceptional leadership, outstanding contributions, and dedication on the international scene in promoting the quality profession. The nominee must be a true quality professional with an international reputation and integrity.

Criteria used by the Lancaster Medal Committee in its evaluation of nominees includes, (1) visibly demonstrable application of outstanding leadership in international quality activities, (2) span of applications reflected in the degree that the nominee provided managerial or technical advancements and understanding to other countries or international bodies, (3) publicity/presentations done internationally, and (4) professional society contributions, leadership, etc.

cn Conti was invited by Prof. Vladimir Lapidus as guest speaker to the Russian Quality Forum held in Nizhny Novgorod from 22 to 24 May 2001. Prof. Lapidus teaches quality management and statistics at the local University. He is also an entreprenneur, having created a few years ago the "Priority Centre", a consulting company in the area of quality management and quality system implementation. I had met him before, at the International Quality Congress in Yokohama in 1996 and in Italy, in 1999, where he was invited by the University of Naples.

The Forum was quite interesting and very successful. About three hundred persons attended it, from Russia and the Community of Independent States (even from Uzbekistan). Very good presentations and very nice people. The Forum was concluded by a memorable trip on the Volga river, with Volga fish and Russian songs.
